FRIDAY 3RD & SATURDAY 4TH MARCH 2023 - LIVE MUSIC IN THE EVENINGS

1	Three Tuns	Solstice	3.9%	Light, refreshing & crisp. A malty straw-coloured ale embodying midsummer. Layered with zesty flavours and a delicious floral fruity bitterness.
2	Ledbury	Harlequin Pale	4.0%	Small-batched release using the Harlequin Hop.
3	Usher's	Celtic Gold	4.0%	A golden bitter with a pleasant balance of hops and malt. Hops continue from the first taste to a smooth bitter finish.
4	Three Tuns	XXX	4.3%	A renowned beer from a recipe passed down by the Roberts family who owned the brewery for several generations; a pale-straw-coloured, premium bitter with simple, light malty-sweetness, delicately balanced with light bitterness of floral, earthy character.
5	Three Tuns	Cleric's Cure	5.0%	Presenting a mild malty sweetness and paired with the bitterness of spiced and floral flavours, Cleric's Cure is our India Pale Ale. Crafted to capture the iconic taste of 19th Century India Pale Ales, this hoppy golden ale is full of personality.
6	Wye Valley	Samurai	4.5%	A cutting-edge amber ale - celia and sorachi hops - intense lemon character
7	Ludlow	Best	3.7%	Best is a well-balanced session ale with a golden-amber complexion. The aroma is of banana, pineapple and sweet toffee while the palate is balanced with both a resinous and dry finish.
8	Goffs	Jouster	4.0%	An All English Hopped Traditional Best Bitter from the Cotswolds.
9	Exmoor	Antler	4.0%	A smooth and warming dark amber beer. Nose of popcorn and soft toffee. Nuts and toffee on the palate spiked by light tropical fruit. Dry grainy/malty finish, typical of Exmoor beers, leaving the taste buds calling out for more.
10	Wye Valley	Wholesome Stout	4.6%	A dark brew that lets its rich coffee notes, intense roasted barley flavours and dry, bitter finish do all the talking.
